At the Tewkesbury roundabout, follow signs for the A438 towards Ledbury/Longdon. Continue on the A438 for a short distance before turning into the Longdon area. Follow local signage and What3Words location for precise arrival at Manor Farm.

From M5 Junction 9 (Tewkesbury):

Exit the M5 at Junction 9 and follow signs for the A438 towards Ledbury. Continue on the A438 heading through Tewkesbury and out towards Longdon. Stay on this road for several miles until reaching the Longdon area. Manor Farm is located off the main road, please use the What3Words reference for the final approach.
